

# DO YOU HAVE PAIN AND DIFFICULTY WITH SWALLOWING? YOU MIGHT BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN A CLINICAL TRIAL

Eosinophilic Esophagitis (EoE) is a condition of the esophagus (tube from your mouth to stomach) that can lead to difficulty swallowing and causing food to get stuck in your throat while swallowing. A type of white blood cell, called an eosinophil, builds up in the lining of your esophagus and causes inflammation. *Eupraxia Pharmaceuticals* is conducting a clinical study to test a new treatment called EP-1041AR which has been formulated as an injection into the esophagus aimed to help those experiencing these symptoms of EoE.



## WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Male and female patients of age 18 years to 75 years old who have been diagnosed with Eosinophilic Esophagitis and have active symptoms of Eosinophilic Esophagitis.

## PARTICIPATION DETAILS

- There is no cost to participate
- This clinical trial is being run by **Dr Nguyen** at the **Royal Adelaide Hospital** and by **Professor Holtmann** at the **Princess Alexandra Hospital**
- Participants are eligible for compensation to cover the cost of time and travel
